#### **TEACHING EXPERIENCE**

## **Ballet and Pointe Technique**

All levels of classical and contemporary ballet technique - Classes incorporate aspects of Vaganova, Cecchetti, and Bournonville techniques with an emphasis on dynamic alignment and breath. Dancers are encouraged to explore their full capacity for

## **Dance Anatomy & Kinesiology**

Academic course focusing on the muscles and systems of the human body – The course explores body function as it relates to the biomechanics and physics of dance technique and performance, common dance injuries, and somatic practices. The course is delivered through lecture, student led presentations, and hands-on studio explorations.

#### **Dance Research Methods**

Academic small group capstone course developed specifically for BFA in Dance Science Majors or any dance major interested in conduction research. The course highlights basic research questions, research methods, and IRB construction. Following the course students typically spend the following semester putting information to practice through the creation and execution of their own small research project. movement within the structure of the technique.

#### Yoga

Hatha yoga class with a focus on dance specific poses and the application of Yoga into warm-up and cool-down practices.

## **Auditioning & Careers in Dance**

Senior capstone course focusing on preparing students to enter the dance workforce. The course outcomes include production of website, performance/choreography reel, artistic statement, teaching philosophy and résumé. Dancers also research dance companies, choreographers, best audition practices, and graduate schools in their field of interest.

#### **Modern Dance**

Modern dance technique – Including classes focused on Limon principles of weight, fall and recovery, and sequential initiation, and Gaga Movement Language inspired improvisation.

#### Jazz Dance

Beginning levels of jazz dance technique, including musical theatre dance forms. Classes focus on basic structure including conditioning, leaps and turns, and extended performance sequences.

## **Backgrounds of Dance**

An academic survey course for dance and non-dance majors, emphasizing the history and influence of ethnic and theatrical dance forms. The course investigates the field of dance history, primal dance, and the development of ballet through the 19th century. World dance forms are also investigated with a focus on how these dance forms personify a society. Videos, student presentations, readings, guest lecturers, and group discussions supplement daily lectures.

## **Conditioning**

Course focused on increasing body awareness and strength in the dancer. Pilates based movement, body weight training, cardiovascular fitness, and weight training are all incorporated into the semester – giving the student the knowledge to create their own conditioning routine.

## **Pedagogy**

This course is structured around understanding the fundamentals of pedagogy, followed by hands on application and feedback within the dance classroom.

#### Composition

Two semester sequence focusing on the fundamentals of choreographic structure, improvisation and choreography projects.

## Study abroad course to London & Paris

This immersive 3-week course begins on campus with lectures and student presentations followed by 14 days abroad where students take daily dance classes, visit 10 different museums, and attend a minimum of 10 dance performances of diverse genres. This course is supported through the International Programs Office.
